ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
SEATTLE GLIDER COUNCIL, INC.

Phillip H. Entz, Robert G. Joppa,  
Alvin J. Jarvis, Yowland D. Gilbert, Peter M. Bowers  
Joseph M. Robertson, and H. Prater Hogue  
being desirous of forming a corporation for  
charitable, educational and other public purposes as hereinafter  
more fully expressed, and which corporation can competently man-  
age, administer and distribute its properties and income for the  
purposes hereof, do make, subscribe and adopt this agreement and  
associate themselves together with the intention of forming a  
corporation under Revised Code of Washington, chapter 24.04, as  
follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be SEATTLE GLIDER  
COUNCIL, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The principal office of this corporation shall be  
located at 1422 North 46 th St., in the City of Seattle,  
County of King, State of Washington. However, said location  
and chief place of business may be changed by the Board of Dir-  
ectors of this corporation in its discretion at any time to any  
other place in the State of Washington.

ARTICLE III.

Membership in the corporation shall be by election of  
the Board of Directors, which election shall be held in accordance  
with the provisions of the By-Laws of the corporation adopted  
from time to time by the members. Termination of membership shall  
be in accordance with the By-Laws. The corporation shall not have  
capital stock nor issue shares.



#### ARTICLE IV.

The objects and purposes of this corporation shall be as described in hereinafter:

(a) To foster, promote, engage in and conduct all phases of motorless flight. To foster, promote, engage in and conduct related social, business and recreational activities of every type, kind and description.

(b) To receive, hold, conserve, administer, use and disburse the properties and income of the corporation for the purposes expressed herein.

(c) To have all other powers granted non-profit corporations by the laws of the State of Washington, or the State in which this corporation is active.

#### ARTICLE V.

The life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE VI.

Section 1. The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall at the beginning be seven in number, but the By-Laws of the corporation may provide for a greater or lesser number thereafter but never less than five. The first members of this corporation shall be those subscribing to this agreement, and they shall also be the initial Board of Directors to serve until the election of their successors by the members, but not more than six nor less than two months from the date of incorporation.

Section 2. Except as in the last paragraph qualified, the members of the Board of Directors shall hold office until their successors shall have been elected, or appointed, and qualified in accordance with the By-Laws.

Section 3. The corporate powers of this corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors and may by the latter,



in accordance with the By-Laws, be delegated in any part to officers, committees and other representatives selected by said Board.

ARTICLE VII.

Upon the termination or dissolution of the corporation any surplus of property and assets remaining after all of the debts and obligations of the corporation have been paid and satisfied shall be divided among the members in proportion to which each member is entitled under the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

The members of the corporation may adopt, amend and repeal By-Laws, rules and regulations not contrary to the Constitution and laws of the United States or of the State of Washington, as the members may deem proper and best for the welfare and good order of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

The provisions of these Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any time by the Board of Directors with the approval of so much of the membership as may be required by law and in accordance with the By-Laws.

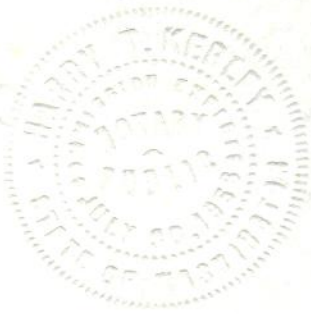
