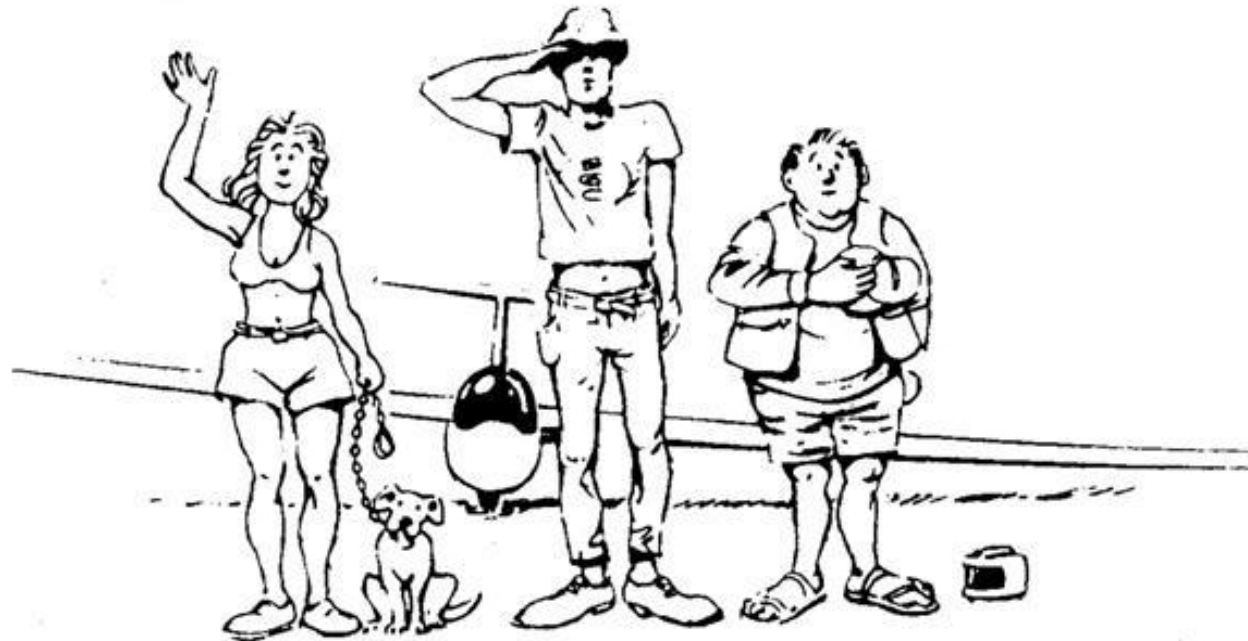

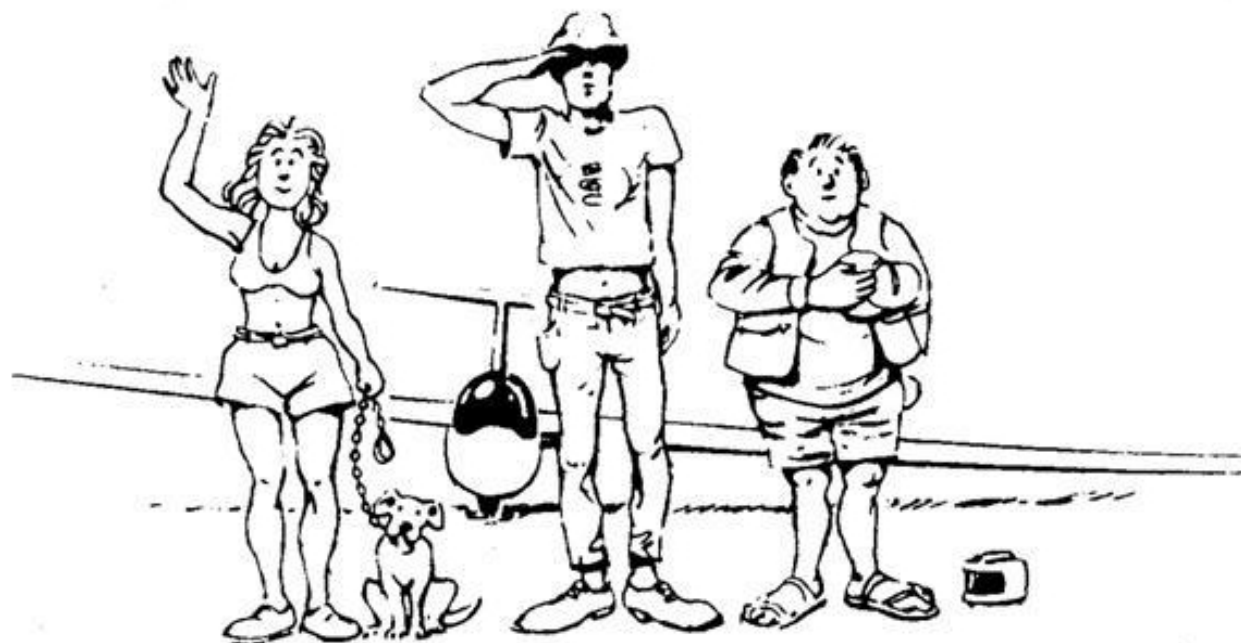

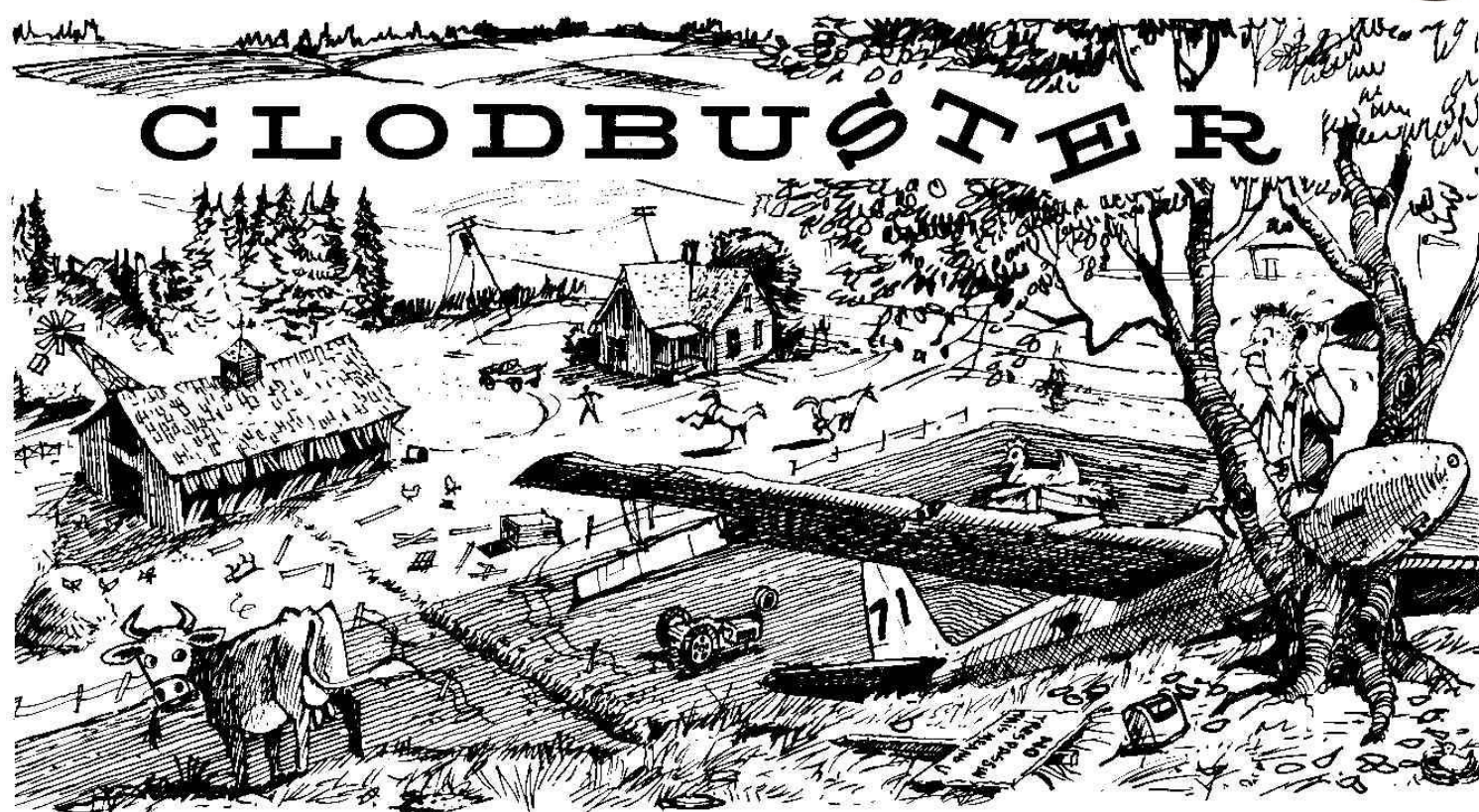
The Seattle Glider Council presents this award for 2019 to:

STUDENT PILOT ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

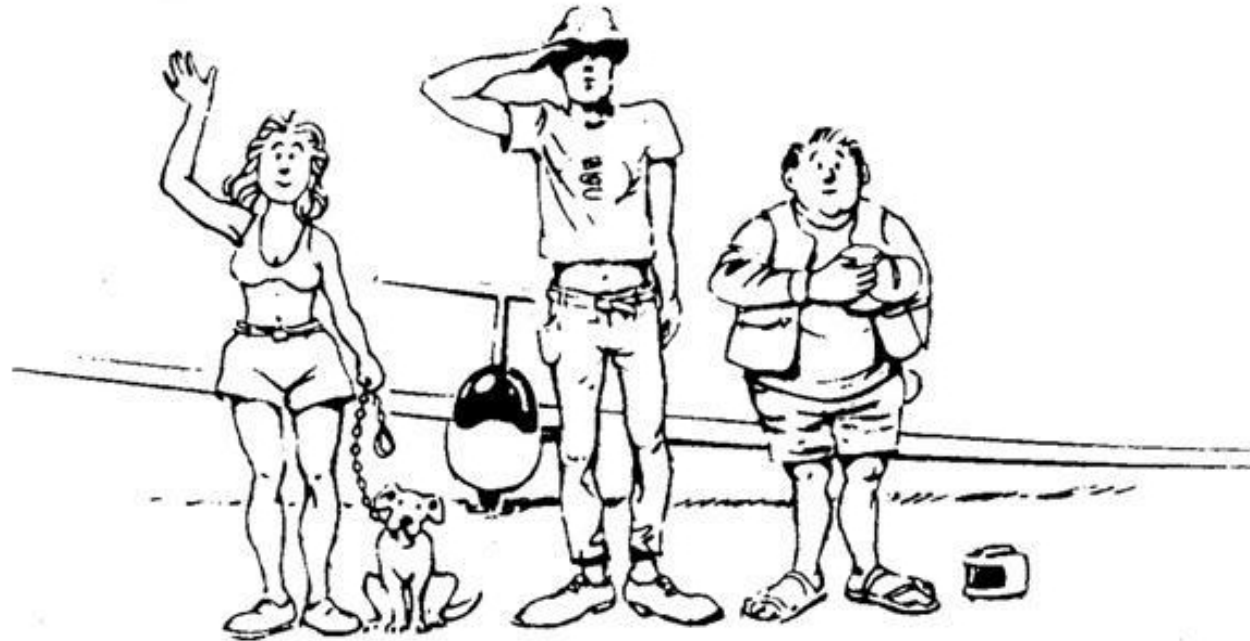


The Seattle Glider Council presents this award for 2019 to:
